FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: Is there a trophy fee if I kill a Pope and Young or Boone and Crockett buck?

A: No. We don't have trophy fees.

Q: Are you a high fenced ranch?

A: No. We are a free range outfitter.

Q: Are crossbows allowed?

A: Yes. You can hunt with crossbow.

Q: What size deer will I be hunting?

A: You will be hunting 120 inch and up with a potential of harvesting a Boone and Crockett Class Whitetail.

Q: Do you have food plots?

A: Yes. We plant numerous plots throughout our properties and you may be hunting over one of them.

Q: Do you have archery only hunting areas?

A: Yes. Contact a member of our staff for more information, if you're interested in hunting one of these areas.

Q: How do I tell if a buck will meet your minimum requirements?

A: Your guide will be happy to give you tips on how to score a buck during orientation.

Q: What is your policy on wounded bucks?

A: If a deer is wounded or blood is drawn and it cannot be recovered your hunt is over. You will have the opportunity to pay a diversion fee of \$500 and continue to hunt. If a second deer is wounded your hunt is finished.

Q: What about caring for the meat and the trophy?

A: The guides are responsible for recovering and transporting the deer back to camp. We have a local butcher that can process or we can process for an additional fee.

Q: What am I responsible for and what do I need to bring?

A: See packing list.

Q: What about food and cooking arrangements?

A: Meals are included in almost all hunting packages unless otherwise specified on site.

Q: I want to bring along a non-hunting guest. Is this allowed? What will it cost?

A: Call for details.
